Borrowing Club Equipment (Summer Program)

Club equipment may be borrowed to facilitate you participating in HJCC events that are external to HOAC, subject to the following conditions;

- All equipment must be signed out in the book (in the top draw of the green shed)
- All equipment must be returned to the green shed at the earliest opportunity
- Equipment must only be used for club events, or when a club coach is present - any exceptions to this must be approved by a club coach or club official
- HOAC "Young Leaders" who are HJCC Members may make arrangement to temporarily keep HJCC equipment in a HOAC locked compound.

Note: Use of equipment outside of a club event is not covered by the clubs insurance and thus is not permitted.

Note: Where equipment usage is approved then the member **MUST** hold BCU membership (see below) to ensure minimum liability cover is in place.

Borrowing Club Equipment (Pool Sessions)

Members without equipment may sign-out club equipment for the winter pool sessions.

- Borrowed equipment must not be stored outside during the winter.

Note: Boats, especially our small Stars, are in short supply, and we will re-allocate club equipment at pool session where necessary to ensure the optimal pairing of paddlers and their ability with the kayaks the club has available.

BCU / Canoe-England Membership
